For the past few days, the children at OSHC have had a great time engaging in the "Laser Tag" activity where they took turns in groups of 12 in the COLA area. Laser tag is a recreational shooting sport where participants use infrared-emitting light guns to tag designated targets. This laser tag activity not only promotes team building, improves gross motor skills and sportsmanship but also improves planning and strategy building skills. As the children have continued to take interest in this activity, we will continue to take the children to the COLA area for laser tag games throughout this week. Mini bricks continued to be another popular activity with the children creating animal related figures and displaying them in the OSHC building. Rabbits seem to be a popular design amongst the children. The children also assigned chores amongst themselves to create landscapes for the animals created.

Play dough that was suggested by Sophia has been popular at the friendship area. Due to Covid, the children each have their own pack of play dough to play with. They used the molds, rollers and cutters to create different patterns. The children enjoyed the activity and Nicola and Hannah have requested for more. On the 18th of March (next Friday), YMCA West Pennant Hills will be celebrating Holi festival. Holi is a popular ancient Hindu festival, also known as the "Festival of Love" or the "Festival of Colours".
